



Order of Merit Nomination Form



What is an 'Order of Merit'?

It is an award presented by the Association of First Aiders for an outstanding contribution in the field of first aid. This honourable award recognises both the first aider and the training providers' excellence.

How do I nominate a person to receive one?

The nomination form must be completed by the person/company who trained the intended recipient in first aid. The training provider must either be a member of the Association of First Aiders or approved by AoFA/AoFAQ. All nominees will receive a certificate and will be put forward for consideration for the National Award which is announced each year at our First Aid Forward Conference. The award is presented at the award ceremony to the trainee and a certificate of excellence recognises the training provider.
